Sometimes, bone marrow edema from osteoporotic fracture is so extensive that no residual fat can be seen on T1 images. Some institutions use chemical shift or in and out-of- phase imaging to differentiate neoplasia from non- neoplastic entities by demonstrating coexistent fat and water in the region.

Reactive versus neoplastic plasma cell proliferation. There are many causes of reactive bone marrow plasmacytosis including infection, malignancy, inflammation, Castleman’s disease, iron deficiency, megaloblastic anaemia, haemolytic anaemia, diabetes mellitus, cirrhosis, 5 and streptokinase treatment. 6 In most cases the plasma cell infiltrate is less than 20% but it can sometimes reach 50%.
