Rule 5.4 - Professional Guidelines and Rules of Conduct ... Federal Practice. Some areas of law are entirely federal in nature and, as such, you may be able to practice them in a state in which you are not admitted to the bar, so long as you are licensed in one of the U.S. states or territories. Such areas include bankruptcy, antitrust, immigration, Social Security, and trademark and patent law.

How to become a lawyer without going to law school - Shareable
(a) A lawyer or law firm shall not share legal fees with a nonlawyer, except that: (1) an agreement by a lawyer with the lawyer's firm, partner, or associate may provide for the payment of money, over a reasonable period of time after the lawyer's death, to the lawyer's estate or to one or more specified

Law Corporations
