On 1 January 1801, Great Britain merged with the Kingdom of Ireland (also previously in personal union with Great Britain) to form the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland. Britain 1500 1750 Presenting the Past

After the Second World War, the landslide 1945 election returned the Labour Party to power and Clement Attlee became Prime Minister of the United Kingdom. The party quickly nationalised critical sectors of the economy, especially declining industries. The Bank of England was nationalised along with railways (see Transport Act 1947), coal mining, public utilities and heavy industry.

PRIME MINISTER •Sir Robert Walpole 1721-1742 –Cabinet developed nearly into its present form •William Pitt the Younger -1783 - 1801 and 1804 - 1806 –Restored the cabinet and prime minister so that the position was responsible to the Parliament and not the King –Prime Minister became the focus of political power in Britain.
