Torn Music Rejected Film Scores

The title is a reference to the most infamous rejected score -- Bernard Herrmann's music for the Alfred Hitchcock film Torn Curtain, literally tearing the Hitchcock/Herrmann partnership to shreads. Hubai begins with 1932's The Most Dangerous Game, and finishes with Gears of War 2 in 2008.
