However, mechanisms of animal toxicity could be more complex. This work investigates the estimated reduction and oxidation potentials of 34 nitroaromatic compounds using quantum chemical approaches.

Structure-Toxicity Relationships of Nitroaromatic Compounds Designed carbazole-based novel fluorophores (TPCADM and TPCA6M) exhibit a sensitive response to toxic and explosive nitroaromatic compounds (NACs) via complex formation, and their detection sensitivity or selectivity can be demonstrated by comparing their emission-quenching rate constant or the adoption of similar-structured aromatic compounds as a negative control.

Mutagenicity of Nitroaromatic Compounds - Chemical ... In this paper, a new simple method is presented for the estimation of the toxicity of nitroaromatic compounds including some well-known explosives. This method can predict the 50% lethal dose concentration for rats (LD 50) as the estimation of toxicity in vivo.
